JSRCC announces new appointments

RICHMOND, Va. (August 11, 2008) – J. Sargeant Reynolds Community College Executive Vice President **Dr. Genene LeRosen** was recently appointed to the Virginia Network of the American Council on Education (ACE), Office of Women in Higher Education (OWHE). As an executive board member, she will coordinate state activities related to the goals set by the ACE and OWHE, including an annual Senior Leadership Seminar for women administrators. Dr. LeRosen has been in administration at JSRCC since late 2002. Prior to her career at Reynolds, she served as the special assistant to the Chancellor of the Virginia Community College System. She has also held positions with Northern Virginia Community College, the Virginia State Council for Higher Education and the College of William and Mary.

The Henrico County Board of Supervisors recently appointed **J. Douglas Freeman, Sr.** to his third term on the J. Sargeant Reynolds Community College Board. He served previously for eight years on the College Board before his term limit was reached in 2005. Freeman has served for the past three years on the College's Foundation Board. A graduate of Princeton University, Freeman also holds an A.A.S. degree in horticulture from Reynolds.

Richard Groover has been named Assistant to the Dean for the School of Mathematics and Science at JSRCC. Groover has been a Reynolds faculty member since 2004, most recently as an Assistant Professor of Biology. He was also honored this year by being named the 2008-2010 Chancellor's Commonwealth Professor.

Serving over 18,000 students annually, J. Sargeant Reynolds Community College is the youngest and third largest of the 23 Community Colleges in Virginia. The College operates three campuses serving residents in the City of Richmond and the counties of Hanover, Henrico, Goochland, Louisa and Powhatan.
