TYPE OF APPOINTMENT:	Full-time nine-month teaching faculty-ranked appointment. Salary commensurate with the education and experience of the applicant. Salary range: \$40,061 - \$85,810. Approximate maximum hiring salary: \$59,709.
QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED:	Master's degree in Information Systems Technology; or Master's degree with eighteen (18) graduate semester hours in Information Systems Technology. The selected candidate must be able to successfully pass the college's pre-employment security screening.
QUALIFICATIONS PREFERRED:	Considerable occupational technical experience or teaching experience in one or more college-level disciplines including Information Systems, Networking, Database, Web Design, Business and Office Technology. Demonstrated experience with mobile application programming. Demonstrated experience or knowledge in developing GIS databases and applications. Demonstrated experience in IT virtualization. Demonstrated experience in Microsoft Office Applications. Demonstrated experience in teaching online and/or hybrid classes. Demonstrated experience in advising students. Demonstrated experience in curriculum development. Demonstrated ability to work with a widely diverse faculty, staff and student population. Demonstrated ability to communicate effectively, both orally and in writing. Prior teaching experience in the community college setting is also preferred.
POSITION RESPONSIBILITIES:	The primary responsibility is teaching. Faculty loads are normally scheduled on an average of fifteen (15) credit hours per semester. Office hours, advising, and collateral duty assignments are expected. Teaching assignments may include day and evening classes at multiple on- and off-campus locations, including dual enrollment. Opportunities for summer teaching will be based on student interest.
